- 1. Call 877-783-3221.
- 2. Text your outage. If you prefer to text rather than call your outage in, members will need to have their cell phone number on file at Norris Electric. Then they will need to complete a short registration process on our website www.norrselectric.com. Once that is complete, members will be able to text their outage in. You will also receive a text when your electric is restored!!
- **3.** Use our app. If members have a smart phone, you can download our app and report your outage.

- * Scholarships are for one year and are not renewable.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on grade point average, college entrance test scores, work and volunteer experience, participation in school and community activities, biographical statement, and knowledge of electric cooperatives as demonstrated by a short essay.
- Deadline for receipt of completed applications and submissions is Feb. 1, 2018.
